This Indenture made this 30th day of April 1804 between
William Weatherford of Montgomery County of the one part
and Mr Morrison of Rockingham County and State aforesaid
of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars in hand paid by the
S^d Mr Morrison on and before the sealing & Delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof acknowledged he the S^d William
Weatherford hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed &
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
alien convey & confirm unto the S^d Mr Morrison his heirs
and assigns forever that pieces or parcels of Land lying
and being in the County of Montgomery & State aforesaid
the one lying on both sides of the Rock hole Creek
beginning at a birch running thence to John Harbells
line thence with S. line to a P. O. then N. 45 Deg. W. 42 Ch.
and 50 links to a P. O. then to the beginning containing
by survey one hundred and seventy one acres also one another
tract of lying in the fork of Rock hole Creek beginning at
a birch on the west bank of the East prong of Rock
hole on Thornton Tallops line running with his line
and passing his corner N. 16 Chains to a P. O. then S. 50 Deg.
W. 44 Ch. 50 links to a P. O. then S. 22 D. W. 44 Ch. to a stake
Christopher Esborns line then with his line S. 8 Ch. to a stone
P. Weatherfords corner of his Deed Land then with the line
of his deeded land N. 36 D. E. 57 Ch. & 20 links to a birch
his other corner with his line again S. 57 D. & 3 Ch. to a
stake on the west bank of the East prong of Rock hole
